## *Be a FOPIC: Live for Christ*

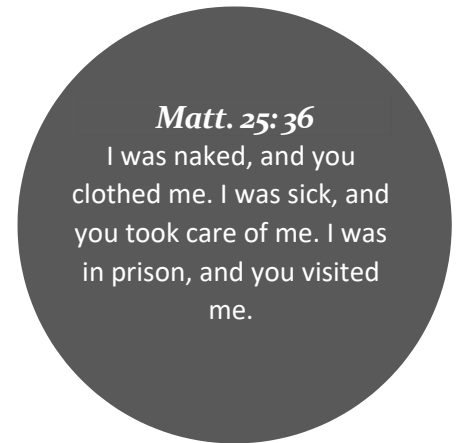
Our goal as an organization is to help people find their purpose in Christ Jesus as quickly as they can.
